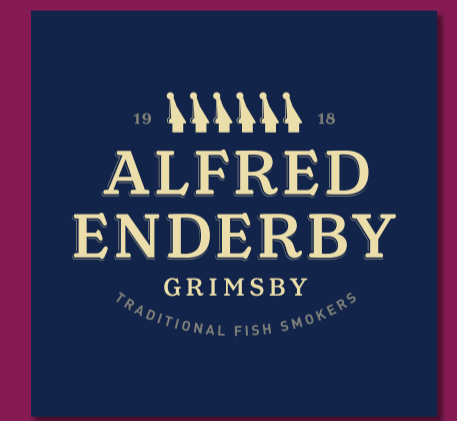
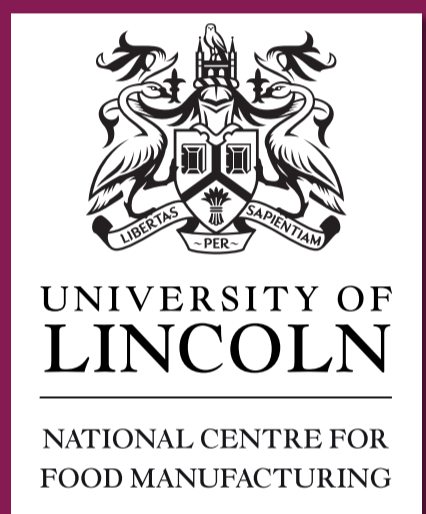

- Seafood sector facts 1**
- Grimsby is the UK's seafood capital with over 60 approved seafood processing sites in the region
  - The seafood industry is worth £1.8 billion to our region
  - Grimsby supplies the vast majority of seafood for all the UK's major retailers, food service and consumer markets

- Seafood sector facts 2**
- Grimsby Fish Market sells up to 15000 tonnes of fresh seafood a year
  - 90% of seafood processed in Grimsby is imported from over 25 countries, lots of travel opportunities
  - North East Lincolnshire is home to both the largest concentration of mobile fishmongers with over 50 travelling the length and breadth of UK selling seafood
  - The region is also home to the largest fish and chip restaurant in the UK

- Seafood sector facts 3**
- The seafood sector provides more than 5000 direct jobs in the region
  - The seafood processing industry is consolidating. Between 2010 and 2018 the industry lost 29 processing sites but gained almost 1400 employees, growing from nearly 3800 to 5160, an increase in employment of over 35% in eight years
  - Seafood processing companies in the area are typically large: the average number of FTE (full-time equivalent) jobs per site is 129

- Facts - Local :**
- Food processing is a multi-billion pound food and seafood processing cluster, centred on Grimsby
  - Grimsby is 'Europe's Food Town' with around 500 food related companies
  - Yorkshire and the Humber is the country's largest food producing region
  - 4.1% of jobs in the Humber area are in food and agriculture (That's nearly 150,000 people)
  - Our area is a major centre for chilled meal production
